



CARES ACT #1 - Student Portion Reporting

1. An acknowledgement that the institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used, or intends to use, no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
 - a. CARES ACT #1 Certification and Agreement was signed on 5/7/2020 and was submitted via grants.gov on 5/12/2020.
2. The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
 - a. CARES ACT #1 was submitted to grants.gov for Delaware County Technical School, Practical Nursing Program (031284) to receive \$75,128.
 - b. CARES ACT #1 funds were received in Delaware County Technical School, Practical Nursing Program's G5 account on 5/28/2020 (P425E204388).
3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of the date of submission (i.e., as of the 30-day Report and every 45 days thereafter).
 - a. CARES ACT #1 funds were disbursed in full to students on 7/1/2020.
 - b. All the CARES ACT #1 funds, \$75,128 were disbursed.
4. The estimated total number of students at the institution eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.
 - a. CARES ACT #1 funds, \$75,128 was divided equally to the 46 students who applied and were eligible for the grant.
 - b. Each student received a refund check for \$1,633.21 or \$1,633.22. Each student was sent a check on 7/1/2020.
5. The total number of students who have received an Emergency Financial Aid Grant to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.

 - b. Funds were divided equally by all eligible applicants, as all applicants were financially impacted by COVID-19.
 - c. Students needed to:
 1. Submit an application
 2. Be Title IV eligible
 3. Describe how the COVID-19 pandemic affected them
 4. Demonstrate how the CARES Emergency Financial Aid Grant funding would be used
