SEPTEMBER 7, 2022 BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

Approval to support professional development opportunities for District and IU staff:

Approval for Wallingford-Swarthmore School District to become a member of the consortium partnership between DCIU and Frontline Education (My Learning Plan).

Approved the purchase of three subscriptions from Acadience Learning, Inc. for DCIU trainers to receive asynchronous training in the Aimsweb data program.

Approved a contract with Brain Pop to provide schools and districts with annual subscriptions to various educational internet-based products at a discounted consortium rate.

Approval of contracts with districts and other partners for programs and services:

Approved contracts with the Southeast Delco School District and the William Penn School District to provide breakfast, lunch, and snacks for 40 students in the two Pre-K Counts classrooms within each district for 180 days from October 1, 2022, to September 30, 2023.

Approved a contract with Rose Tree Media School District for DCIU to provide up to 60 hours of behavior consultation to various students and IEP teams across the district.

Approval to enhance student learning and work experience and support future educators:

Approval for up to 60 students and up to nine advisors to attend the SkillsUSA Leadership Conference from November 16, 2022, to November 18, 2022, at the Kalahari Resort and Convention Center, Pocono Manor, PA.

Approved an articulation agreement with the Pennsylvania College of Technology for Advertising Design and Commercial Art students to receive up to six credits, effective September 8, 2022, to be reviewed annually.

Approval to continue the articulation agreements with Neumann University for Exercise Therapy & Sports Science students to receive up to nine credits; Advertising Design & Commercial Arts students to receive up to six credits; Early Childhood Education students to receive up to five credits; Health Sciences students to receive up to six credits, and Medical Careers students to receive up to six credits during the 2022-2023 school year.

Approval of other grants, contracts, leases, appointments, and services:

Approved a contract with the Child Care Professional Network to provide a Child Development Associate (CDA) credentialing course for Early Head Start/Head Start/Child Care Partnership parents and staff from October 4, 2022, to May 23, 2023.

Approved a contract with the William Penn School District from September 1, 2022, to June 30, 2024, for managed security services.

Approval to accept the Carl D. Perkins Grant for the 2022-2023 school year for the Delaware County Technical Schools.
